2615 Review of the Neighbourhood Plan written by the Steering Group

It was agreed that the Steering Group have put a lot of time and effort into producing the Neighbourhood Plan for the parish with a lot of research being carried out and they are to be commended for this. The Council records its appreciation.

The contents of the Plan were discussed and some amendments are to be recommended. It was thought that some of the long-term strategies are too specific. However it was generally thought that the Plan is too long and too wordy and the format needs to be reviewed. It was suggested that few people are likely to fully read the 50+ page document. Cllr Scott had already done some work on modifications and was encouraged to continue with this. Mr Paul Hatch, Lancaster City Council Planning Officer is to be contacted for advice. Approval of the Plan was deferred as it did not quite meet the standard expected by the Parish Council.
